The versatile Alan will be bringing alto, tenor and baritone saxes, whilst Bruce will be blowing some tasty stuff on both trumpet and flugelhorn. Composer, teacher and arranger as well, he leads a busy life. The bonus on 10th is an appearance from his protégé, the sensational Steve Fishwick, now regarded as one of the most exciting trumpet stars in Britain. They have played for us before at the "old place" and it turned out to be one of the best gigs ever. Another one not to miss, especially as this is our only June gig.
